Drying time	Under normal drying conditions touch dry in 2 hours, recoatable in 2 to 4 hours. Allow for adequate ventilation during the drying period.

PREPARATION	
New surfaces	
<u>New surfaces</u>	All surfaces must be sound, clean, suitably dry and free from anything that will interfere with the adhesion of the materials to be applied. Powdery, polished plaster or dense surfaces should be primed or stabilised. Porous surfaces should be 'mist' coated by diluting with up to 40% clean water by volume.
Previously painted surfaces	
	All surfaces must be sound, clean, suitably dry and free from anything that will interfere with the adhesion of the materials to be applied. Remove all loose and flaking or suspect material to a sound surface. Prime or Stabilise as required.
COATING SYSTEM	Apply two coats over primed, mist coated or previously painted surfaces.

	Where a large colour change is being undertaken and extra coat may be required.
APPLICATION	Stir well before use. Apply by good quality brush or roller. A medium pile roller is best for smooth plaster surfaces. For airless spray (dilution may be required). For further information follow the spray manufacturer's guidelines.
CLEANING	Return surplus material to container. Wash equipment with clean water immediately after use.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Take special precautions during the surface preparation of pre 1960's painted surfaces as they may contain harmful lead. For further information contact our Customer Relations Team.
